## 2023 Pool Rules

#### **General Rules**

- 1. Flotation devices or pool toys are not allowed in the pools, with the exception to coastguard certified life jackets (Toys are allowed in Baby Pool)
- 2. Ladders and stairs must be used to enter and exit all pools
- 3. No horseplay/excessive splashing in the pools, no dunking, or climbing on shoulders.
- 4. All chairs, towels and other personal possessions must remain behind the yellow line.
- 5. The pool management has the right to change the rules as deemed necessary for the overall safety and improvement of the pool environment.

### **Front Desk**

- 1. No Trespassers
- 2. Badges are not transferable (ID Cards)
- 3. No Loitering
- 4. All guests must accompany and remain with their sponsoring member who is 18 years or older
- 5. All sponsoring members must remain with their guests for the entire stay at the pool
- 6. Guest Passes are not refundable
- 7. One adult member may bring up to 5 guests in one day
- 8. Strollers are not permitted on the upper deck
- 9. No eating or drinking on the upper deck, with the exception of water
- 10. No glass bottles are permitted on the premises
- 11. No gum chewing
- 12. The pool is not responsible for any lost or stolen goods
- 13. No running anywhere on premises
- 14. Adult swims can be called on the hour starting at 1pm until 5pm. Adult swim lasts for 20 minutes.
- 15. No pets are allowed in the pool facility, with the exception of working dogs
- 16. No one is allowed in the pools when a lifeguard is not present
- 17. Dressing and undressing is permitted in the locker rooms only
- 18. No use of skateboards, scooters, roller blades, bicycles, heelies or hover boards
- 19. Smoking is not permitted in the pool facility
- 20. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted
- 21. The pool management has the right to change the rules as deemed necessary for the overall safety and improvement of the pool environment

## 2023 Pool Rules

#### **Main Pool**

- 1. Patrons are only permitted to sit on the wall in the pool between the stairs and the ramp
- 2. Diapers are not permitted in the main pool and all bathers must be potty trained
- 3. Toys are not permitted in the main pool
- 4. Lap lanes are for continuous swim only
- 5. Please use the ramp to enter and exit the pool only
- 6. Please keep stairs clear
- 7. The pool management has the right to change the rules as deemed necessary for the overall safety and improvement of the pool environment

### **Training Pool**

- 1. The wall by the lifeguard chair must remain clear in the Training Pool
- 2. Training Pool is only for children 8 years or younger
- 3. Toys, snorkels and fins are not permitted in the pool
- 4. The pool management has the right to change the rules as deemed necessary for the overall safety and improvement of the pool environment

### **Baby Pool**

- 1. Baby Pool is only for children 5 and under
- 2. Chairs by the Baby Pool should be against the wall or on the grass only
- 3. Water guns are not permitted
- 4. Food is not permitted in the Baby Pool
- 5. Please keep the area around the lifeguard chair clear
- 6. The pool management has the right to change the rules as deemed necessary for the overall safety and improvement of the pool environment

## **Diving Tank**

- 1. The far side of the diving tank (16ft) is only for adults
- 2. The high diving board in the Diving Tank is only for diving or flipping
- 3. All swimmers under the age of 18 must pass the deep water test in order to use the Diving Tank
- 4. Swimmers cannot wear goggles when using the diving boards or platforms
- 5. No cartwheels, handstands, or other dangerous actions off the diving boards or platforms
- 6. The pool management has the right to change the rules as deemed necessary for the overall safety and improvement of the pool environment

#### Slide

- 1. All children need to be deep water tested in order to use the slide
- 2. Swim to the outside ladder
- 3. Sit before proceeding feet first down the slide
- 4. Don't crowd around the open slide
- 5. The pool management has the right to change the rules as deemed necessary for the overall safety and improvement of the pool environment
